civil rights activist and congressman.**

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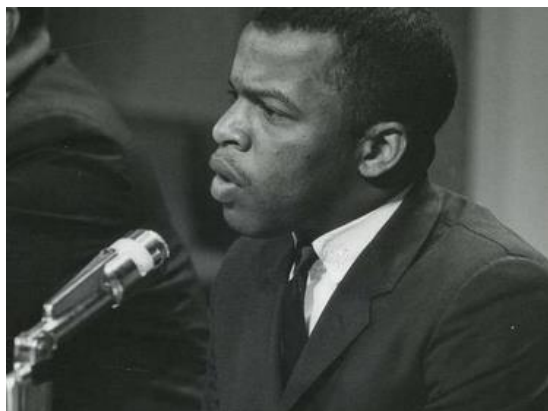
What is something that needs fixing in our own country? What doesn't sit right in your hearts that moves you to protest in a nonviolent way? What can you do to get in good trouble?
